Deadline Dates for Submitting Applications

April 15 – Summer School (If Applicable)

June 1 – Fall Semester

November 15 – Spring Semester

Note: The summer school deadline date is listed as “If Applicable” due to the possibility of not having summer school from year-to-year. Please check Haskell’s website for current announcements.

Commonly Asked Questions In Relation To Deadline Dates

Question: I am a high school senior, when should I send in my application materials for admission?

Response: *High School seniors can send in applications as early as February if they are considering attending for the Fall semester. Please keep in mind that we will need a current transcript (also referred to as a 7th semester transcript) and we will need a final official transcript after graduation.*

Question: I have all my materials together but I am waiting on one item, should I go ahead and send in what I have?

Response: *Yes, it is common to receive materials at different times and submitted materials are documented electronically as to date of receipt. Additionally, all items are filed immediately in applicant files.*

Question: I have turned everything in. When will I hear back from Haskell?

Response: *We will respond within one-two weeks to let you know one of the following: 1) your file is complete and a decision on admittance will be forthcoming, 2) your file is missing required documents or; 3) if you have been accepted or not. As the deadline date approaches, we receive a large volume of applications so this response time may be extended. You are always welcome to call the Office of Admissions and if staff is not available, we will call you back.*
